Participant Engagement Plans



Do you want your child's support worker time to be achieving goals? Do you want the time to be more than just hanging out? Do you want your child learning, engaging, growing, exploring, building confidence?

What is a Participant Engagement Plan?

A **PEP** is a specifically designed plan for your child using their NDIS goals and the goals your allied health team want your child to achieve.

It is designed to assist support workers and mentors in giving them specific, measurable, achievable, realistic and time bound goals for your child.

Whilst Awen's Social Workers set the goals and plan, support workers implement it. We work with support workers to make sure that your child is engaging in their community where they are achieving goals each and every session.

Who designs a PEP for my child?

Our Social Workers consult your psychologist, speech therapist, OT or anyone else supporting your child. Social Workers are experts in building complex case plans and speak the language of allied health. This process is a team effort and we make sure that your child's team are all involved.

How does a PEP work?

Our Social Workers consult, build and execute the plan. We send the PEP to your support worker through a link, they review the goals and then report back to us via a link. We can then track your child's success and report back to your team with success and concerns.

Participant Engagement Plans



Do Support Workers have to follow a PEP?

This is completely your call. If this is a service you feel would benefit your child then we will work alongside your support worker. Our goal is to make sure that your child receives care that sees goals being achieved.

Do you change goals at all?

Absolutely. When PEPs are returned back to us by support workers, our Social Worker team monitor the level of success. If the goal has been achieved then we develop the next goal. If it needs to be altered then we make sure that occurs immediately.

How much does it cost my child's plan?

To design, implement and monitor your child's PEP costs around 6-10 hours at \$193.99 for a year, depending on the number of goals. We provide you with a quote and make sure that we work within the budget.

NDIS Reporting and PEPs

Each participant receives a monthly report on goals. These are also shared with your team. If you require a final report for NDIS reviews then we are more than happy to provide this at \$387.98.
